

AT-300 Automatic Mandown QUICK START GUIDE









 Mandown Transmitter with Necklace.
 When activated the transmitter will send a signal to the Receiver. The Mandown transmitter has 3 an On/Off switch on the side to activate or deactivate the transmitter unit. Be Sure to switch to "OFF

The transmitter code is marked on the unit and is preset at the factory. There is the capability to change the code, If used with the EC-1 or CE-300 enunciator.

The AT-300 may be worn on the necklace and detects resident Fall at any angle. No false alarms from bending over, swinging necklace, etc.

Important! Be sure to <u>test your</u> <u>system often</u>, with transmitter at locations where patient may be.

The AT-300 may also be pinned to clothing above the waist. Such as on clothing, inside shirt pocket, outside or inside sweater or coat. The transmitter must be secured so that it can not fall to a horizontal (flat) position which would activate the alarm.

Important! Be sure to turn your transmitter "OFF" whenever you are not upright or laying transmitter down, to avoid false alarms.

Another way to wear the AT-300 is attached to a belt clip. Be sure to attach it so the unit is upright.

The belt clip should be adjustable to maintain upright position of transmitter.

Belt clips are available at Pager and electronic supply stores.

EC-1 - Emergency Caller Unit; Receiver/Dialer Pull for Help Transmitter-wrist band and necklace.

The Mandown AUTOMATIC TRANSMITTER sends the signal to call for help up to 100 feet indoors (depending on structure, metal obstacles etc.). Be sure to test your system often as range may be effected by conditions.

Changing Batteries:

The batteries should be replaced every year or as needed with your transmitting unit: To replace the batteries in your transmitter you will need two 3-volt Lithium batteries (CR2025 or equivalent). Carefully remove the screws on the transmitter case and separate the transmitter housing. Carefully remove the circuit board inside, and avoid touching any of the components. Remove the old batteries from the battery clip and place the new batteries under the clip with the positive ends of both batteries facing up.
